“My husband took other women because I gave birth to female babies; he wanted boys through these lovers. One of my husband’s lovers came to my house asking for forgiveness. My husband had left her with a baby girl. We hugged each other and cried.”

“For 33 years I hated the lady who was the lover of my husband. (He’s been dead for 28 years now). During the introductions, today, I realized that she is here in this place and that she is a member of this ministry. I want to forgive her. Dear sister, please stand up. I want to forgive you, and will no longer hate you. I don’t want to be a handicap to this ministry.”

“My husband also left home for the same reason, he wanted a baby boy. I only birthed girls. His last child outside of our marriage is living with me and she was given my name. All this I am doing in the love of Jesus Christ.”

Praise the Lord for what He is doing in the lives of women. “For nothing is impossible with God” (Luke 1:37).

Give Praise and Thanksgiving...

1. That in 2009 Project Hannah’s (PH) *Women of Hope* (WoH) program went on the air in Romanian, Berber-Kabyle, Amharic, Gujarati and Swedish and is now available in 53 languages. Please continue to pray for these programs as God uses them to touch the lives of women in Romania, Algeria, Ethiopia, India and Sweden.
2. That the Romanian WoH program is aired in the cities of Constanta, Zalau, Suceava, Sibiu, and Cluj and from “Filadelfia Radio.” It is on the Internet at www.radiofiladelfia.ro and the Swedish WoH program is on the Internet at www.hannascafe.se.
3. That Marli’s book, *When Hope Wins* (edited by Ros Atkinson and translated into German by Ilka Jones) was distributed at ERF’s 50th Anniversary Celebration in Germany. Praise the Lord for the marvelous work He has done in the lives of the women in the book and thousands of others around the world. Please continue to pray for the publication processes for the English and other versions.
4. For the 4,000 people involved in the 198 Angolan PH prayer groups that meet regularly for prayer, do evangelism in prisons, maternity wards, hospitals, orphanages and centers distributing food, clothes and baby items, giving hope to women and their families.
5. That a strict new legislation passed in Brazil for the offense of molesting a child under the age of 14 now carries a penalty of between eight and 15 years in jail. “The northeast of Brazil has for some years had a problem of pedophiles traveling to the area, often from overseas, and strongly-worded warnings about the penalties for exploiting children are posted in most hotels” (BBCNews.com).

6. For the Asia Consultation in Thailand hosted by Buakab and the Voice of Peace/PH team where WoH producers from Cambodia, India, Nepal, Myanmar, Philippines, Taiwan and Vietnam as well as guests from Australia, Europe, Singapore and the United States were encouraged and challenged.



7. That Marli was invited to speak to the women at the International Orality Network (ION) conference and several significant contacts were made. Ros Atkinson, PH’s International Script Producer, and Fran James, Australian volunteer, were also able to attend.
8. That the Vietnamese WoH production team met for training with Marli. They also met at a house church with 12 listeners/intercessors/follow-up workers, encouraging them with a word from the Lord and prayers. Praise the Lord for the 350 prayer cells in Vietnam!
9. For Project Hannah’s 12 years of ministry reaching out to women through awareness, prayer and radio programming.
10. For intercessors who joined PH’s annual 40-day season of prayer and fasting. “Because of the great spiritual battle I needed renewing and restoration. When I joined the group of prayer and fasting, it gave me new hope: pray more for others. In the beginning I prayed

in the morning and at night but then I dedicated my whole day to prayer. The Lord strengthened me thru the Holy Spirit and I increased my prayer and fasting to three days a week. I found much peace and new strength in the Lord. I took the prayer calendars that you sent to my church and I distributed them to everyone. My heart was on fire and it continues that way – thank God!” (Uruguay)

- 11. For discussions with other ministries (Stoncroft Ministries, Campus Crusade for Christ) about working together to reach women with God’s love and care.
- 12. For the women and men who gave their lives to Christ after listening to WoH radio programs or being visited by PH staff who shared God’s love with them.
- 13. That after Marli met with the Women’s Commission in the Philippines, several women asked how they could be a part of PH’s ministry and offered to be coordinators in their area of Metro Manila.
- 14. For PH’s dear friend, Gracia Burnham, and the Burnham Foundation that has supported several WoH programs and has recently offered a \$20,000 matching grant to support broadcasts in Cebuano, Tagalog, Ilocano and Indonesian.
- 15. For the International WoH production team. Tammy Stores and Carol Detwiler will co-host the WoH English program, and Marvin Heath is producing the program. International guests will also be featured on these programs that will be heard in the Caribbean, Fiji, Liberia, Papua New Guinea

and South Africa, with the potential of reaching millions.

- 16. For WoH listeners who are blind or have other disabilities but continue to rejoice in God’s goodness. Pray for those who are taunted by family members saying hateful things like, “Where is your Jesus? You are still blind.”
- 17. That countries like South Africa are beginning to address the rape crisis that has devastated women and girls for way too long. Pray that more leaders will step up and defend women and girls against the horrors of rape, child marriages, prostitution, domestic violence, female genital circumcision, widow abuse and forced abortions.
- 18. That India’s capital, Delhi, has recorded more female than male births for the first time in many decades. Pray that leaders around the world will enforce laws that protect female babies from abortion and early death from neglect because the family wants male children.
- 19. For the Women’s Conference in Ethiopia and for God’s touch on the lives of women, men and children as they listen to the Amharic WoH program. Praise the Lord for those from other beliefs who are hearing God’s truths and accepting His gift of salvation.
- 20. For the wonderful time the 210 women at the Women’s Conference in Kenya had with the Lord through praise, worship and prayer.
- 21. That Marli had the opportunity to minister to 200 Cambodian women listeners and intercessors (10 accepted the Lord) and met with another 20 women at different churches.

- 22. That generous financial gifts helped keep Bulgarian, Central Asian, Kazakh, Portuguese, Romanian and Ukrainian WoH programs on the air in Europe and the Nepali program on the air in Asia. Two microphones were also purchased for the new Nepali WoH team.
- 23. That Brazil is passionately seeking ways to reach the Ticuna women with the WoH program in the Ticuna language. Pray for Denora and Cecilia as they translate and contextualize scripts.
- 24. For faithful single women who are serving God in some difficult places. Pray for their safety, health and family relationships. Pray also that others will come alongside them and encourage them.
- 25. For wives who serve the Lord and faithfully pray for their husbands to accept God’s gift of salvation.
- 26. For God’s sustaining grace on PH staff members who have been very ill or have lost loved ones this year. “My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness” (2 Corinthians 12:9).
- 27. For WoH listeners who have invited neighbours and family members to listen to the program with them.
- 28. That young single mothers are receiving love and help from PH staff as they struggle to find answers to life’s tough problems. Give thanks for the babies who have not been aborted.
- 29. That Hirut and Asrat were able to visit the Fistula Hospital in Ethiopia and receive helpful information to use in a WoH

program. Pray for women who struggle with the humiliating complications that come from fistula injuries.

30. For the unknown answers to our prayers and for the many lives that have been touched by God. “Jesus did many other things as well. If every one of them were written down, I suppose that even the whole world would not have room for the books that would be written” (John 21:25).
